MYTH BUSTER: suffocated in:

18% weighed

More than 57% of the Pet food/treat bags 12% dogs who suffocated Cereal box liners 6% weighed OVER 30 lbs. Bread bags, 18% weighed plastic containers, and more 14% OVER 60 lbs!
